

NON-COOPERATION EXPLANATION	
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Section 960.13(1)(b), F.S., requires that in order to be eligible for benefits, the **claimant/award recipient** must cooperate with appropriate authorities in the prosecution of the offender. However, an exception to this requirement may be considered when there is a good reason for non-cooperation.
